PERSPECTIVE PLAN, 2017-22

Criterion I: Curricular Aspects

- To maintain Teacher's diary for planning and curriculum.
- To introduce post graduate and research programs in Science especially Chemistry, Botany and Zoology.
- To introduce skill based add-on short term courses to enhance job / Self-employment potential of students.
- To introduce NSQF certificate courses.
- To introduce additional divisions to fulfill and cater varied demands of the students.
- To motivate faculty to participate in 'design and restructuring of syllabi' process at university level.
- To conduct workshops related to syllabi and to depute faculty attend such workshops.
- To establish the well-structured feedback system related to curriculum, teachers and Institutional performance, from the stake holders.
- To provide good academic flexibility at UG and PG levels.
- To start short term add on courses like Fashion Designing, Beauty Parlor etc.

- To protect college campus with wired fencing.
- To develop botanical garden and flowering beds.
